Blessing After Blessing: Morgan's Story



Morgan came to Ruth's House from a treatment facility with five young children in tow, and pregnant with her sixth child. She shares, "Any fears that I felt were immediately put to rest when staff answered the door and welcomed my children and I with open arms and a genuine care for our needs. I came with very little and was immediately provided with clothing and personal hygiene items for me, and for my children. Staff set up a playpen for my youngest son in a large bedroom that would become my family's home for the next few months.

During my time at Ruth's House, staff worked with my younger children to ensure they were meeting their development milestones, with their learning disabilities. I was connected with local resources to help me move towards my goals, and staff also helped me develop a plan for childcare so I could find a job. Ruth's House set up volunteers so that I could attend AA meetings, which was really important to me so I could maintain my sobriety, for myself and for my children. The residents and I began a weekly devotional time on Sunday evenings to get to know each other and so we could talk about issues we were facing. I found encouragement through this group, and a great circle of friends. I also shared encouragement and offered to be a listening ear, a shoulder to cry on, and a support system for the other women."

After leaving, Morgan stayed in Rice County because Ruth's House helped her to build a life within the community. She shares, "I truly believe that God answered my prayers when He opened the door to Ruth's House of Hope for me and my children. I needed their facility and resources to gain control back of my life, to maintain my sobriety, and to become a stronger independent mother for my children. Ruth's House showered my family with blessing after blessing, from the material things we needed such as clothing, diapers, and personal hygiene, to the emotional and spiritual support. I found a new determination to get control of my life back. I'm forever grateful to Ruth's House!"

"I came to Ruth's House with my infant son after fleeing a dangerous situation with my baby's father. I had nowhere to turn until I found **safe refuge** at Ruth's House. There, I found the **support** and **resources** I needed to **break free** and **succeed** on my own. I have since **secured** my own apartment and am **enjoying** every moment spent with my son building our **new life**!"

RUTH'S HOUSE OF HOPE, INC.

THE MISSION and GOAL

In 2004 Ruth's House opened in response to an unmet local need for safe housing and supportive services for homeless women and children. We are a nonprofit Emergency and Transitional Shelter in Rice County for women and children who are homeless, or at risk of becoming homeless, due to domestic violence or other traumatic life circumstances such as illness, disability, substance use disorders, or poverty.

Our mission states: "Empowering lives, offering hope through transitional housing and support."

Ruth's House **vision** is that every person has a safe place to call home, and our **goal** is to end homelessness, one family at a time.

THE PROGRAM

The Emergency and Transitional Shelter can accommodate nine families of women and their children for up to 60 days in emergency circumstances and up to 4 months as a transition to permanent housing, with the option of an additional six months to address more difficult barriers to self-sufficiency. Programming includes individualized support that helps families stabilize and work toward increasing life skills and self-determination to end the cycle of poverty and homelessness:

Strength-based case management with goal setting and weekly progress meetings
Ruth's House is staffed and available for support 24-hours daily, 7 days a week at our shelter
Children's programming, including a weekly preschool class and a weekly mother/child class with McKinley Early Childhood Center

Financial education with volunteer Kurt Halverson
 of Hometown Credit Union

Parenting and renters classes

Family-friendly group outings

 Connections with an array of community resources

Staff at Ruth's House continually work with residents on obtaining economic health. Staff encourages and assists women in obtaining employment, and training is provided for job application/ interviewing skills. Educational opportunities are encouraged and staff assists women with obtaining their GEDs, completing certifications, or enrolling in post-secondary education.

Staff utilizes trauma-informed services and a clientcentered approach when working with residents to most effectively address their needs.
